

FAQ's

QUESTION: Are all members of AFRC eligible or just HQ AFRC members?

ANSWER: Eligibility is based on being a current participating member (or immediate family member) of the Air Force Reserve, not just a HQ AFRC member.

QUESTION: Is the scholarship opportunity open to children of AFRC civilians?

ANSWER: No, there must be a military service affiliation.

QUESTION: Is the scholarship for people going to college or do technical schools count?

ANSWER: A technical school student is eligible as long as the student is receiving grades and meets all other scholarship prerequisites

QUESTION: My son/daughter is still in high school but just got accepted into college, do they qualify?

ANSWER: Yes - however, they must have a letter of acceptance to a college, so new graduates, or soon to be graduates with an acceptance letter qualify. They must submit their high school transcripts along with the letter of acceptance from college with their application per the guidance.
