SUBJECT: 94th Airlift Wing Environmental Commitment Statement

- 1. This policy applies to military personnel, civilian employees, contractors, and other persons performing work on Dobbins Air Reserve Base. As host of this installation, the 94th Airlift Wing provides mission ready forces while sustaining our natural infrastructure through the implementation of our Environmental Management System (EMS).
- 2. As stewards of the environment, we make the following commitments to ensure that our EMS supports our mission to maintain combat-ready aircrews and eight C-130s deployed in response to worldwide contingencies and emergencies, including transportation for deployments, humanitarian airlift missions and aeromedical evacuation, by:
- a. Complying with applicable federal, state, local, Department of Defense and Air Force environmental regulations and policies, supported by regularly scheduled internal assessments;
- b. Ensuring our employees are aware of, and follow AFPD 90-8, the environmental, safety, and occupational health policy for the Air Force (AF);
- c. Committing to continual improvement by establishing environmental goals, measuring progress, taking corrective action when necessary, communicating necessary information regarding the installation's operations and environmental accomplishments, and responding to any regional/local environmental concerns;
- d. Integrating sound environmental practices into our routine decisions and activities, promoting conservation of energy and use of sustainable natural and manmade materials; and
- e. Educating our employees about their responsibilities to protect the environment and enhance the mission.
- 3. The commitments identified above shall be integrated into our daily operations in order to maintain a sustainable environment to perform the Wing's mission.
